The citation formats shown here are based on modified guidelines from the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association*, 5th edition, 2001, Chapter 4, pages 215-281, and from the APA Style Web site at <http://apastyle.apa.org/>

Access the PJC LRC article databases from the library homepage <http://lrc.pjc.edu> by clicking on **Most Used Article Databases** (lower left of page) or **Find Articles** (top of page). Articles from these online databases were initially published in magazines, newspapers, scholarly journals or other reference sources. **Always cite the article publication information first, followed by the database information.** Most of the library databases now include citation guidelines for each article.
