Articles cited from magazines:

Author(s) of article. "Title of Article." *Title of the Magazine* (italicized). Date of publication:

Pages (or n. pag. if none given). *Name of the database* (italicized). Web (medium of publication). Date of access in day, month, year format. [**abbreviate all months** except May, June, July.]

Pages (or n.pag. if none given). *Name of the Database* (italicized). Web (medium of publication). Date of access in month, day, year format.
