The citation formats shown here are based on guidelines from the MLA Handbook for Writers of Research Papers, 6th ed., 2003, Section 5.9.7, pages 229-230.

Access the PJC Library article databases from the library homepage <http://library.pjc.edu> by clicking on **Most Used Article Databases** (lower left) or **Find Articles** (top). Articles from these online databases were initially published in magazines, newspapers, scholarly journals or other reference sources. **Always cite the article publication information first, followed by the database information.** Most of the library databases now include citation guidelines for each article.
