

## HOW TO CITE ARTICLES AND ESSAYS REPRINTED IN THE GALE LITERARY CRITICISM PUBLICATIONS AND THE LITERATURE RESOURCES FROM GALE DATABASE USING MLA FORMAT

The Gale Literary Criticism series gather and organize articles, essays and reviews containing literary criticism and reprint them in their publications. They also reproduce much of this material in their online database, Literature Resources from Gale. Essentially when you cite a source reprinted in either the Gale Literary Criticism print collection or the Literature Resources from Gale database, you **document the information for the original work and then cite the source in which it was reprinted or reproduced**.

The citation formats shown here are based on guidelines from the MLA Handbook for Writers of Research Papers, 6<sup>th</sup> ed., 2003. If a citation runs more than one line, **indent** all subsequent lines. **Double-space** the citations in the **Works Cited** page. Single spacing was used here to save space. ### CITING FROM THE GALE LITERARY CRITICISM VOLUMES:

To cite a previously-published article reprinted in a Gale Literary Criticism volume, give the complete data for the original publication. Add *Rpt.in* (“Reprinted in”), the title of the Gale Literary Criticism series, and the publication information located on the title page of the Gale volume. Add the pages from the volume. See the following examples:

## CITING FROM THE LITERATURE RESOURCES FROM GALE DATABASE

All of the citations below are from Literature Resources from Gale, a subscription database available online to registered PJC students. Many, but not all, of the sources from the Gale print series are reproduced in this database. **Document the information for the original work, cite the source that reprinted or reproduced it, and then add the name of the database that contains this information, the name of the database provider, the name of the library that subscribes to the database, the date the information was accessed, and the home page URL of the database.** See the examples below:
